For support of those at ages 2 through 15, the fee is \$20 (P1000) per month.

**Each Sponsorship covers the following:** tuition, enrollment, books, uniform, registration, dental checkup, insurance, medical checkup, ID card/jacket, instructional materials, PTA & library & campus fees, school publications, graduation fee & gown, field trip transportation costs, boy/girl scout membership & uniforms, gym fee, and basic school supplies (notebooks, pencils, etc.).

## JOG ACROSS AMERICA

*"Run 2,000 miles!"*

Wow, American food is sooo delicious! Hmm, how to keep my weight down so I don't have to buy new clothes? Got it! In each state we visit (there are 30), I try to jog between 3 and 15 miles each day (except Sundays and "driving days"). My goal in these 7 months is to run 2,000 miles. Occasionally I am able to join a race or walkathon, and as I run, I have headphones to listen to tapes of the Bible. The goal is to go from Genesis to Revelation three times. I'm now up to Samuel. 210 miles so far, and 1,790 to go!

## PREACH ACROSS AMERICA

*"We need 88 sponsors!"*

12 different denominations of churches have invited us to share about our exciting work in the Philippines. Added to that are four civic clubs and a few elementary/ middle schools and colleges, plus Bible studies, etc. At BLC we have 212 poor sponsored kids and 75 paying children, bringing the total 2006 enrollment to 287. Our goal for 2007 is 375, which means we need 88 more sponsored kids. Thus far in our travels 11 people have come up to us and expressed their desire to sponsor a child. Only 77 more sponsors to find!

#### **BLC ENERGY FUND:**

EVERY DAY AT BARNER LEARNING CENTER, WE SUPPLY TRANSPORTATION FOR 290 STUDENTS. OUR BUSES WERE BOUGHT WITH FUNDS SACRIFICIALLY & GENEROUSLY GIVEN BY FAITHFUL FRIENDS.

A CHURCH IN PENNSYLVANIA, USA SENDS ABOUT \$300 EACH MONTH TO ASSIST WITH THE FUEL FOR THESE VEHICLES. HOWEVER, WE PAY \$750 EACH MONTH FOR GAS.

WITH THE RECENT FUEL INCREASE, OUR ENERGY BILL FOR THE BUILDINGS ON CAMPUS HAS TRIPLED TO \$800 PER MONTH.
